Entries will be judged by top design professionals from Architecture and Interior Design firms within New England. All official entries will be showcased at the Awards presentation on March 6, 2019 at Boston Park Plaza, Boston, 50 Park Plaza, Boston MA 02116.

DELIVERABLES

A total of six (6) PDF sheets (combined into a single PDF document, or split into individual PDF documents).

Please note the entrant's name and information shall not be listed on any sheet for judging confidentiality.

Each sheet shall be:

- 11" x 17"
- PDF Format
- Landscape Orientated

Each sheet shall have the following base information.

Sheets and content listed below are for guiding purposes only. Students to use their own discretion in ascertaining the best way to convey the essence of their project within a 6 sheet format.

- Sheet 1: Inspiration/Concept
- Sheet 2: Floor Plan
- Sheet 3: Reflected Ceiling Plan
- Sheet 4: Finishes
- Sheet 5: Elevations and/or Rendered Perspectives
- Sheet 6: Rendered Perspectives and/or Imagery

Your 250 word (max) description should include a client profile, project objectives, design concept and solutions, design challenges, team contributions, and sustainable design efforts. It is important to be descriptive yet concise. The narrative should support project photography.

Note: IIDA New England reserves the right to eliminate any entries that do not meet minimum submission requirements. You may upload individual sheets or multiple sheets in one .pdf file. Each file must be 2MB or less.
